FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Students admitted into the Batten Honors College will be awarded either a full-tuition Batten Fellowship or a two-thirds tuition Schumadine Scholarship. Twenty scholarships of each amount will be awarded every year. Additional need-based financial aid is also available to those students who qualify.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the Batten Honors College is highly selective. Consideration will be given to applicants for freshman admission with the following qualifications:

- High school GPA equal to or greater than 3.5 *in combination with either:*
- ACT score equal to or greater than 27
- SAT score equal to or greater than 1300 *(test taken March 2016 and later)*

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process requires the following:

- Virginia Wesleyan University application
- Batten Honors College application
- a resume and letter of recommendation
- on-campus interview
