Questions to Consider When Thinking About Studying Abroad

	Have I talked to my advisor about my desire to study abroad?
	What major/minor/gen ed requirements do I have yet to complete? Do I have electives I can take?
	Do I want to/can I take classes in the host language?
	Are there courses I have to take abroad? Are there courses I can only take at VWU?
	Do I want to do an internship or research abroad?
	Does this program offer at least 6-8 courses I could possibly take?
	Would the dates of this program require me to return after the start of a VWU semester?
	Will I be 1-2 credits SHORT in meeting my major/minor requirements?
	Does the program offer a language pre-course or semester language option?
	Do I have accommodations that need to be taken into consideration?

Have I done research? (E.g. Library, Wikipedia, Blogs, Talking to international or returned students)
Do I have an interest in this country?

What type of housing are you interested in?
Do I have food allergies?
Am I a LGBTQIA+ student or a student of color?
What "extras" does my program offer?
Am I a student athlete and want to play or practice my sport or need access to a gym?
