



# University Parking Agreement

*Alumni are always welcome on campus, but please be aware and agree to the following University parking expectations:*

**General Vehicle Regulations and Parking:** The person whom the vehicle is registered on campus is held fully responsible for any violation involving the vehicle, even if another person was using the vehicle at the time of the violation. The University assumes no liability for damage to or theft of any vehicle or its contents, or for the injury or death of anyone involved in a vehicular accident while on University property. If the vehicle to which the sticker is registered is transferred or sold, the previous owner must remove the sticker and submit a new online decal request form.

## **Parking Decal Placement**

Parking decals must be AFFIXED to the inside, top left corner of the windshield.

## **Parking**

Alumni may park in any non-reserved space; unmarked (Examples of reserved space: disabled parking, Faculty-Staff, Guest/Welcome Center or Reserved 24-hr). It is the driver's responsibility to find a legal parking place. Lack of a convenient space is not a valid excuse for violating parking regulations.

## **Speed Limit**

The maximum speed limit on campus at any time is 25 miles per hour.

## **Handicap Parking**

Only vehicles with proper state issued handicap license plates or decals may park in these spaces. Virginia Beach Handicap Parking Enforcement issues citations on campus.

## **Administration of Regulations**

Traffic and parking regulations are enforced by Campus Security. All regulations are in effect 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

*At the discretion of the Director of Campus Security and/or the Director of Alumni Relations, repeated violations of parking and traffic regulations may result in restricted parking or revocation of driving/parking privileges on University property.*
